The request must bear an original signature of the chief, sheriff, or director of the requesting agency. 2. This completed form must accompany the formal written request on <u>each</u> vehicle for which an undercover or protective plate is requested. 3. An undercover, protective plate will be issued only to operators that are full time, sworn and commissioned law								

enforcement officers (extenuating circumstances will be reviewed on a case by case basis). 4. The GSD/TSD retains the right to demand the return of any or all Undercover or Protective Plates if the responsible agency: abuses the purpose of the Undercover/Protective Plate program; routinely uses the vehicle for stopping motorists for minor traffic infractions; the driver or the vehicle receives citations or warning for traffic violations, overtime parking or abuse of handicapped parking privileges. 4. All other provisions of the Undercover/Protective Plate program policies and procedures issued May 1, 1996 and revised April 1, 2011 shall remain in effect. 5. Non-compliance with MVD/TSD policies and procedures, misuse or abuse of the Undercover/Protective Plate program may result in the agency's non-participation in the program. I hereby certify that the information provided is true and correct - I understand that misuse may result in my agency's non-participation in the
